

"Open up the debate to integrate broader issues!"



"Focus the debate on small scale, concrete level!"

"Experiment with temporary measures to signal openness of the process!"


"I would never work with temporary measures again!"

"Slower, more incremental implementation!"






"Invest more in involving disadvantaged groups!" (e.g. 'on the street'-consultations, more languages)

"Focus participation on representative formats!" (e.g. "citizen assembly")



In interviews with stakeholders and in scientific accounts we often find contradictory experiences.

"Activate potential supporters at an early stage!" (active coalition building, "transition management")



"Try to approach potential opposition groups at an early stage!" (e.g. local businesses)?

"Informing everybody at an early stage is key!"
