





### Accessibility to Different Modes of Mobility






2011: Bicikelj bicycle-sharing system (public-private partnership)

21 neighboring municipalities in the Ljubljana Urban Region












### Cycling and Pedestrian Infrastructure

- new footbridges








### A City of Good Accessibility

- our vision is to make this concept even stronger








### Koseze New Pedestrian-Only Area

- around 5000 inhabitants




Implementation challenges:










### Regreeneration project
